ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant
Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance
("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ticor Title Insurance Company of Florida ("Petitioner") is a Nebraska domiciled
insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact title insurance in Arizona
effective August 22, 1996.

2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Chicago Title Insurance
Company (CTIC), NAIC No. 50229, the surviving entity, a Nebraska domiciled insurer effective
May 31, 2010. CTIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily
surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Nebraska approved the merger of Petitioner into
CTIC on May 28, 2010.

4. Petitioner has no insurance obligations under any policy of insurance to any
policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

1 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
2 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

3 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
4 ("IERF").

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
7 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

8 **ORDER**

9 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

10 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
11 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
