CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Ramkumar Vivekanand Boddupalli** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ramkumar Vivekanand Boddupalli ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/health and life producer, Arizona license number 942953, which expires January 31, 2013.
2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: 9336 E. Raintree Rd., Scottsdale, Arizona 85260 (business and mailing); 1701 E. Meadowbrook Ave., Apt. 345, Phoenix, Arizona 85016 (prior residence address); 2626 Thousand Oaks Drive, #204, San Antonio, Texas 78232 (current residence address).
3. On or about April 29, 2009, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident accident/health and life producer, Arizona license number 942953.
4. On September 1, 2009, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his business/ mailing address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before October 2, 2009.

1 5. On December 28, 2009, the Department notified Respondent a second time by
2 mail at his residence address of record that it was about to initiate an administrative action
3 against his license for failure to comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department
4 requested a response by January 31, 2010.

5 6. On or about January 6, 2010, Respondent responded to the Department's letter
6 stating that he had moved to Texas.

7 7. On January 19, 2010, the Department notified Respondent by mail and his new
8 residence address of record that he needed to surrender his Arizona resident license or
9 convert his resident license to a non-resident license.

10 8. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
11 Department.

12 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

13 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

14 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
15 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
16 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

17 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
18 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

19 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
20 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
21 A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

22 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
23 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

2 **ORDER**

3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 4 1. Respondent shall immediately submit to the Department a full set of fingerprints
5 and an Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form.
- 6 2. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department a civil money penalty in the
7 amount of \$150.00.
- 8 3. The hearing, Docket #10A-159-INS, scheduled for February 8, 2011, at 8:00
9 a.m. is vacated.

- 17 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law
18 and Order.
- 19 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of
20 Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the foregoing
21 Conclusions of Law and Order.
- 22 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be
23 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
Order.

1 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
3 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
5 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
6 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
7 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

8 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
9 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
10 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
11 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
12 action on any license application.


