The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Respondent has unlawfully offered or issued service contracts in the State of Arizona. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-1095.09(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. ShieldStar Home Warranty, LLC ("Respondent" or "ShieldStar") is a New Jersey limited liability company that issues service contracts to Arizona residents. ShieldStar's addresses are: P.O. Box 8068, Red Bank, New Jersey 07701; and 119 Maple Avenue, Suite 201, Red Bank, New Jersey 07701.
- 2. SheildStar does not hold a permit to offer or issue service contracts in the State of Arizona.
 - 3. ShieldStar is not exempt from the permit requirement.
- 4. On or about January 19, 2010, ShieldStar issued a home warranty service contract to Reginald Doughty ("Doughty"). On or about August, 2010, Doughty filed a Complaint with the Department stating that ShieldStar denied a claim he submitted for payment for repairs to his air conditioning unit.
- 5. On September 15, 2010, the Department's Consumer Affairs Division sent a letter to ShieldStar requesting that ShieldStar explain its position, on or before October 12,

2010, regarding the issues and allegations raised by the Doughty complaint and to name its underwriter.

- 6. To date, ShieldStar has not responded to the Department's request for information and documentation.
- 7. On November 3, 2010, the State of Washington, Office of Insurance Commissioner issued an Order to Cease and Desist: In the Matter of ShieldStar LLC dba ShieldStar Home Warranty, ShieldStar and www.shieldstar.com and David J. Cohen, Abe Tobias and Albert Houlou aka Albert Houllou (Exhibit A).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes offering and issuing service contracts without a permit, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-1095.01(A).
- 3. Respondent is not exempt from the permit requirement, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-1095.02(A).
- 4. Service company contracts issued by Respondent are enforceable and valid contracts, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-1095.05.
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to order Respondent to cease and desist its violation pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-1095.09(B).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from offering or soliciting warranty service contract applications, taking or proposing to make any warranty service contract, taking or receiving any application for warranty service contracts, taking or collecting any premium, fees, commission, or any other consideration for any warranty service contract, issuing or delivering warranty service contracts to residents of this state, or otherwise offering or issuing service contracts to Arizona residents.

- 2. Respondent shall pay all valid claims arising out of acts covered by any and all service contract issued by them to Arizona residents for so long as such claims may legally be brought against the contract holders.
- This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Pursuant to Title 20 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Respondents are hereby notified that they may request a hearing pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-161 to contest the order to cease and desist. Such a request must be in writing and received at the following address within thirty (30) days from the date hereof:

Upon receipt of a timely written request for hearing, the Director will issue an order setting the time and place of the hearing.
