The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Infinity Title Agency, LLC has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Infinity Title Agency, LLC ("Infinity Title" or "Respondent") is, and was at all 1. material times licensed as a resident title agent, Arizona license number 964492, which expires April 30, 2014.
- Respondent's business address of record with the Department is: 1 E. 2. Camelback Road, Phoenix, Arizona 85012.
 - 3. TSA Ventures, LLC is a Member of Infinity Title.
- On or about April 19, 2010, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance 4. license as a resident title agent, license number 964492.
- On August 11, 2010, the Department notified Respondent by mail at its business 5. address of record c/o Lynn Kramer that Lynn Kramer's fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before September 11, 2010.

- 6. On August 26, 2010, the Department sent a second letter to Respondent c/o Lynn Kramer, 3200 North Central Ave., Phoenix, Arizona 85012, notifying it that it had until September 15, 2010 to submit a full set of fingerprints for Lynn Kramer to the Department.
- 7. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the Department for Lynn Kramer.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2) as applied to title agents under A.R.S. § 20-1561(E).
- 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1) as applied to title agents under A.R.S. § 20-1561(E).
- 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(2) as applied to title agents under A.R.S. § 20-1561(E).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(B) as applied to title agents under A.R.S. § 20-1561(E).
- 6. Grounds exist for the Director, in addition to or instead of any suspension, revocation or refusal to renew a license, impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars, or impose a civil penalty of not more than two thousand five hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of fifteen thousand dollars, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F) as applied to title agents under A.R.S. § 20-2561(E).

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Respondent shall immediately submit to the Department a full set of fingerprints and an Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form for Lynn Kramer.
- 2. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department a civil money penalty in the amount of \$250.00.
- 3. The hearing, Docket #11A-009-INS, scheduled for April 13, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. is vacated.

Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against it and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that it must report this administrative action to any and all states in which it holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
- 7. Cobra Collier, represents that she is Vice President of Title Security Agency of Arizona, Inc., which is the sole member and manager of TSA Ventures, LLC which is a member of Infinity Title Agency, LLC and, as such is authorized to enter this Consent Order on Respondent's behalf.
