**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING
LIFE AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATOR
CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION
AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY
FOR HEARING**

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **IHC Administrative Services, Inc.** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. IHC Administrative Services, Inc. ("Respondent") holds a certificate of registration as a life and health administrator in Arizona.
2. Respondent's address of record with the Department is: 2101 West Peoria Ave., Suite 100, Phoenix, Arizona 85029-4928.
3. On January 3, 2011, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the Department that Respondent's life and health administrator bond was to be cancelled effective February 3, 2011.

1 4. As of February 3, 2011, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this
2 State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State¹.

3 5. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5 1. The Director has jurisdiction.

6 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each
7 administrator possess and maintain a surety bond in a form acceptable to the director and
8 issued by a corporate surety authorized to transact business in this State, within the meaning
9 of A.R.S. § 20-485.10.


10 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
11 41-1092.11(B).

12 **ORDER**

13 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

14 1. Respondent's life and health administrator certificate of registration is summarily
15 suspended effective immediately.
