**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING
BAIL BOND AGENT LINE OF
AUTHORITY AND NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

9 The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **James Wade** has
10 violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious
11 nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds
12 that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the
13 meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

14
15 1. James Wade ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona
16 license number 951157, which expires on April 30, 2013.

17 2. Respondent's address of record with the Department is: c/o All Out Bail Bonds,
18 139 W. Mohave, Phoenix, Arizona 85003 (business and mailing); 11158 E. Flossmoor Circle,
19 Mesa, Arizona 85208 (residence).

20 3. On October 20, 2010, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the
21 Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective November 17,
22 2010.

1 4. On March 4, 2011, Developer's Surety and Indemnity Company notified the
2 Department that it was cancelling Respondent's bail agent bond effective 30 days after receipt
3 of the notice, or on April 1, 2011. However, the Department has never received notice of a
4 Developer's Surety and Indemnity Company bond for Respondent.

5 5. Therefore, as of November 17, 2010, Respondent has not maintained a bond in
6 favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.

7 6. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 1. The Director has jurisdiction.

10 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail
11 bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety
12 insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.


13 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
14 41-1092.11(B).

15 **ORDER**

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

17 1. Respondent's bail bond agent license, Arizona license number 951157, is
18 summarily suspended effective immediately.
