ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING BAIL BOND AGENT LICENSE AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Kurtis Rae Campbell** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Kurtis Rae Campbell ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent,
 Arizona license number 918425 which expires on February 29, 2012.
- 2. Respondent's addresses of record are: c/o Copper State Bail Bonds, 54 W. Main St., #3, Mesa, Arizona 85201 (business); P.O. Box 21144, Mesa, Arizona 85277 (mailing); and 6992 W. Quail Ave., Glendale, Arizona 85308 (residence).
- 3. On April 16, 2010, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective thirty (30) days after the receipt of the notice.

- 4. On October 26, 2010, the Department notified Respondent that the surety holding Respondent's bond was cancelling the bond effective May 16, 2010.
 - 5. To date, Respondent has failed to replace the cancelled surety bond.
- 6. Therefore, as of May 16, 2010, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.
 - 7. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction.
- 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.
- 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's bail bond agent license, Arizona license number 918425, is summarily suspended effective immediately.
