9	The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that Shannon Marie		
10	Tracy has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the		
11	serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona		
12	("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency		
13	action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).		
14	FINDINGS OF FACT		
15	1. Shannon Marie Tracy ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent,		
16	Arizona license number 923397 which expires on April 30, 2012.		
17	2. Respondent's addresses of record are: 1543 W. Grand Ave., Phoenix, Arizona		
18	85007 (business); c/o Liberty Bail Bonds, 1543 W. Grand Ave., Phoenix, Arizona 85007		
19	(mailing); and 18490 N. 114 th Lane, Surprise, Arizona 85379 (residence).		
20	3. On March 16, 2011, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the		
$\begin{bmatrix} 1 \\ 21 \end{bmatrix}$	Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective on April 10,		
-	2011.		

- 4. On March 24, 2011, the Department notified Respondent that the surety holding Respondent's bond was cancelling the bond effective April 10, 2011.
 - 5. To date, Respondent has failed to replace the cancelled surety bond.
- 6. Therefore, as of April 10, 2011, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.
 - 7. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction.
- 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.
- 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

 Respondent's bail bond agent license, Arizona license number 923397, is summarily suspended effective immediately.
