9	The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that Brett Kenneth		
10	Hall has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the		
11	serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona		
12	("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency		
13	action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).		
14	FINDINGS OF FACT		
15	1. Brett Kenneth Hall ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent,		
16	Arizona license number 967749 which expires on September 30, 2013.		
17	2. Respondent's addresses of record are: 1010 E. Indian School Rd., Phoenix,		
18	Arizona 85014 (business and mailing); and 1001 E. Brae Burn Dr., Phoenix, Arizona 85022		
19	(residence).		
20	3. On January 27, 2011, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the		
21	Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective thirty (30) days		
22	after receipt of the notice.

- 4. On February 3, 2011, the Department notified Respondent that the surety holding Respondent's bond was cancelling the bond effective February 27, 2011.
 - 5. To date, Respondent has failed to replace the cancelled surety bond.
- 6. Therefore, as of February 27, 2011, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.
 - 7. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction.
- 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.
- 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's bail bond agent license, Arizona license number 967749, is summarily suspended effective immediately.
