CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Corrie Marie Deal ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 929402, which expires August 31, 2012.

2. Respondent and her dependants were at all material times insured by American Heritage Life Insurance Company under life and health insurance policy number 80-Z4328214.

3. On or about June 30, 2011, Respondent altered a medical billing statement from Rady Children's Specialists of San Diego and submitted it to American Heritage Life Insurance Company with a falsified claim form on behalf of her dependent daughter.

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

3 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes knowingly presenting,  
4 causing to be presented, or preparing with the knowledge or belief that it will be presented a  
5 written statement to an insurer that contains untrue statements of material fact or that fails to  
6 state any material fact with respect to a claim for payment or benefit pursuant to an insurance  
7 policy, which is a fraudulent practice and unlawful under A.R.S. §20-463(A)(1)(c).

8 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20  
9 within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

10 4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes using fraudulent,  
11 coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial  
12 irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere within the meaning of  
13 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(8).

14 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew  
15 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to  
16 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

17 **ORDER**

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

19 1. Respondent's license is revoked effective immediately upon entry of this Order.
