- Petitioner is duly qualified and authorized as a captive insurer in the State of Arizona.
- 3. No evidence has been produced that would indicate or form the basis for a finding that the Agreement and Plan of Merger previously filed with the Department:
 - Is contrary to law;
 - b. Is unfair in the terms and conditions of the exchange of securities;

files its Articles of Merger with the ACC on or before March 31, 2012.

1	5. The Department shall release the \$100,000 statutory deposit of the Insurer to the			
2	Petitioner after the Department receives the following: (a) an ACC certified copy of Petitioner's			
3	ACC filed Articles of Merger; (b) a fully executed Form E126CD (Request for Release of			
4	Certificate of Deposit) and a Treasurer Release Receipt Form E101; (c) payment of any			
5	outstanding IERF invoices, and (d) the filing of the Insurer's 2011 Annual Statement, together			
6	with payment of all applicable fees. The Director has no personal liability for the release of			
7	such deposit so made by her in good faith as provided in A.R.S. §20-588(B).			
8	6. The Department shall refund to the Insurer the \$100.00 that was previously			
9	credited to the IERF, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
