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Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Petitioner is currently licensed in the State of Arizona as a captive risk retention group.
- Petitioner is re-domesticating as a captive risk retention group to the State of

  Vermont.
  - 3. Petitioner surrendered its Arizona Certificate of Authority to the Department.
- 4. Petitioner filed with the Department certified copies of Resolutions of the Petitioner's Board of Directors and the Petitioner's shareholder authorizing Petitioner to, among other things, request approval of the Department to transfer Petitioner's domicile from Arizona to Vermont, and for Petitioner to take any and all other actions necessary and appropriate to effectuate the re-domestication.
- 5. Petitioner filed with the Department copies of its conditional Vermont Certificate of Authority, Articles of Restatement and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation.

Petitioner's insurance obligations shall continue as obligations of the Petitioner upon and after its re-domestication to the State of Vermont. 2 Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund 3 ("IERF")... 4 The Petitioner requested termination of the irrevocable and unconditional letter 5 of credit that the Department holds on behalf of the Petitioner. 6 7 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW 8 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217, Title 20, Chapter 4, Article 14 and with A.A.C. R20-6-303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and 9 10 its withdrawal from the insurance business. 11 ORDER 12 1. Petitioner may file with the State of Vermont and the Arizona Corporation 13 Commission (ACC) its Articles of Domestication or equivalent document(s) in order to effect its 14 re-domestication. 15 Petitioner shall provide the Department with: (a) a copy of the State of Vermont 2. 16 filed Articles of Domestication or equivalent document(s), (b) a copy of the State of Vermont 17 filed Articles of Restatement and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, (c) a copy 18 of the non-conditional State of Vermont Certificate of Authority, (d) a Certificate of Good Standing issued by the State of Vermont, and (e) a copy of the ACC filed Articles of 19 20 Domestication or equivalent document(s). 21 22 23

1,	3. Petitioner's request to terminate the letter of credit is granted. The Department
2	shall release the Petitioner's letter of credit after the Department receives the following: (a)
3	payment of any outstanding IERF invoices, and (b) the filing of the Petitioner's 2011 Annual
4	Statement.
5	4. Petitioner shall pay its Certificate of Authority renewal fee to the Department
6	unless it files Articles of Redomestication or equivalent document with the ACC on or before
7	March 31, 2012.
8	5. Petitioner shall file its 2012 Annual Statement with the Department unless it files
9	Articles of Redomestication or equivalent document with the ACC on or before December 31,
10	2012.
11	6. The Department shall refund to the Insurer the \$100.00 that was previously
12	credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
13	7. Petitioner's request to terminate its Certificate of Authority is hereby approved.
14	The effective date of such termination shall be the effective date of the Articles of Restatement
15	and Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation filed by Petitioner in the State of
16	Vermont, subject to Petitioner's filing with the Department the documents required by
17	paragraph 2 of this Order.
