ORDER

9 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant
10 Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance
11 ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

13 1. Scor Global Life Reinsurance Company of America ("Petitioner") is a Delaware
14 domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and
15 disability insurance in Arizona effective December 28, 1973.

16 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Scor Global Life Americas
17 Reinsurance Company (SGLARC), NAIC No. 64688, the surviving entity, a Delaware
18 domiciled insurer effective December 30, 2010. SGLARC is authorized to transact insurance
19 in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

20 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Delaware approved the merger of Petitioner into
21 SGLARC on September 22, 2011.

1 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether
2 written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are
3 residents of this State.

4 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
5 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

6 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
7 ("IERF").

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


9 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
10 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

11 **ORDER**

12 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

13 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
14 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
