CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Toni Marie Gatling** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Toni Marie Gatling ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident personal lines (P&C) producer, Arizona license number 973979, which expires November 30, 2013.

2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: 6645 W. Bell Road, Suite A-105, Glendale, Arizona 85308 (business); 1231 Greenway Drive, Suite 600, Irving, TX 75038 (mailing); and 8092 W. Paradise Lane, #2053, Peoria, Arizona 85382 (residence).

3. On or about September 14, 2010, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident personal lines (P&C) producer, Arizona license number 973979.

4. On March 22, 2011, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her mailing address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set

1 of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before
2 April 21, 2011.

3 5. On August 17, 2011, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail
4 at her residence address of record that it was about to initiate an administrative action against
5 her license for failure to comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a
6 response by September 15, 2011.

7 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
8 Department.

9 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

11 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
12 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
13 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

14 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
15 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

16 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
17 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
18 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

19 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
20 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
21 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

22 ORDER

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent may surrender her insurance producer license, Arizona license
number **973979**.

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
