The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Northern Arizona Bail Bonds, LLC, Matthew Ray Ogden and Raymond Neal Ogden have violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Northern Arizona Bail Bonds, LLC ("Northern AZ BB") is an Arizona corporation. Arizona Corporation Commission records show that Raymond Neal Ogden became the Manager/Member of Northern Arizona Bail Bonds, LLC on July 26, 2007. Northern AZ BB is not licensed with the Department as a bail bond agent.
 - 2. Raymond Neal Ogden is the Statutory Agent for Northern AZ BB.

- 3. Matthew Ray Ogden ("Matthew Ogden") is licensed with the Department as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 945544, which expires on March 31, 2013.
- Matthew Ogden's addresses of record are: c/o Gurley Street Bail Bonds, 3610
 E. Penny Lane, Cottonwood, Arizona 86326 (business and mailing) and 4510 E. Stevens
 Way, Rim Rock, Arizona 86335 (residence).
- 5. Raymond Neal Ogden dba Gurley Street Bail Bonds, Twin Peaks Bail Bonds and Cottonwood Bail Bonds ("Raymond Ogden") is licensed with the Department as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 896621, which expires on December 31, 2014¹.
- 6. Raymond Ogden's addresses of record are: c/o Gurley Street Bail Bonds, 3610 E. Penny Lane, Cottonwood, Arizona 86326 (business, mailing and residence).

Dankemeyer Complaint

- 7. On or about April 9, 2012, Robert Dankemeyer ("Dankemeyer") filed a Request for Assistance with the Department ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleged that Northern AZ BB failed to post a bond and failed to return premium and fees.
- 8. On or about November 29, 2011, Yavapai County arrested and booked Dankemeyer into the Yavapai County Jail in case CR201100524.
- 9. On or about November 30, 2011, Dankemeyer contacted Matthew Ogden and requested that he post a bond in the amount of \$15,000.
- 10. On or about December 2, 2011, Northern AZ BB secured an appearance bond for Dankemeyer from American Surety Company, Power of Attorney # 358762 ("Dankemeyer

bond"). Northern AZ BB charged \$11,845.00 (\$1,545.00 premium, \$10,300.00 collateral) to Dankemeyer's credit card for the Dankemeyer bond. Matthew Ogden incurred \$245 in fees to purchase the Dankemeyer bond. In addition, the credit card company charged \$300 to process a charge of \$10,000 and a merchant fee of \$45.00.

- 11. On or about December 2, 2011, Matthew Ogden posted the Dankemeyer bond with the on-duty detention officer and the Yavapai County jail. The Yavapai County Sheriff did not release Dankemeyer because the Probation Office had placed a 72-hour hold on Dankemeyer.
- 12. On or about December 6, 2011, Yavapai County Court filed an Arraignment on Petition to Revoke ("Minute Entry"). In the Court's Minute Entry, the Court states that the case is dismissed without prejudice and that Dankemeyer should be released.
- 13. On or about December 6, 2011, the Yavapai County Sheriff released Dankemeyer.
- 14. On or about April 16, 2012, Northern AZ BB refunded \$11,255.00 (\$11,845.00 less \$245.00 in fees, a \$300.00 processing fee and a \$45.00 merchant fee) to Dankemeyer's credit card.

Failure to Post Premium Rates

15. On or about April 12, 2012, an Investigator from the Department traveled to Northern AZ BB. The Investigator discovered that Respondents had failed to post their premium rates at their place of business.

Failure to Keep Bond Log

16. On or about April 12, 2012, the Investigator requested that Respondents produce a bond long. Respondents were unable to produce a bond log.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Northern AZ BB's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes acting as a bail bond agent in this state without a license, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-340.01(A).
- 3. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes failure to maintain, as a minimum requirement for permanent office records, a daily bond register as required under A.R.S. § 20-340.01(F).
- 4. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes failure to post the premium rates of the surety insurer in a conspicuous manner in the place of business, in violation of A.A.C. R20-6-601(E)(1)(b).
- 5. Raymond Ogden's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 6. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes violating any provision of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 7. Respondents' conduct, as alleged above, constitutes demonstrating incompetence or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(8) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.
- 8. Grounds exist for the Director to order Respondents to cease and desist operating Northern AZ BB as an unlicensed bail bond agent pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-292 as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.

- Respondents admit the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona, and admit the foregoing Findings of Fact and consent to the entry of the foregoing
 Conclusions of Law and Order.
- 3. Respondents are aware of their right to notice and hearing at which they may be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondents irrevocably waive their right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.
- 4. Respondents state that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to them to induce them to enter into this Consent Order and that they have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
- 5. Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency, including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
- 6. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
