The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Trapper Lee Moore ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, casualty, and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 950905, which expires on December 31, 2012.
- 2. Respondent's addresses of record are 929 W. Buffalo Trail Camp Verde, AZ 86322 (business/mailing) and 312 Old Woman In Cave, Camp Verde, AZ 86322 (residence).
- 3. Respondent was at all material times contracted with Farm Bureau Mutual Insurance Company ("Farm Bureau") to transact insurance on its behalf in Arizona.
- 4. Between April 29, 2010 and May 30, 2011, Respondent created and submitted 26 fictitious property/casualty and life insurance policy applications to Farm Bureau for which Farm Bureau paid him \$16, 407.42 in commissions. Respondent inserted his business

address in the space provided on the applications to be used for the applicant's residence address and used fictitious phone numbers on 4 of the applications.

5. Farm Bureau has since recouped its losses of unearned commissions by charging back Respondent's agent account.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes intentionally misrepresenting the terms of an actual or proposed insurance contract or application for insurance within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(5).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere, within the meaning of A.R.S.§20-295(A)(8).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license is revoked effective immediately upon entry of this Order.

- 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)
