The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Eric Mau ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, casualty, and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 997006, which expires on August 31, 2015.
2. Respondent's addresses of record are: c/o Farmers Insurance, 7420 E. Pinnacle Peak Rd., Suite 120, Scottsdale, AZ 85255 (business/ mailing) and 17212 N. Scottsdale Rd., #1018, Scottsdale, AZ 85255 (residence).
3. Respondent was at all material times contracted with Farmers Insurance Company ("Farmers") to transact insurance on its behalf in Arizona.
4. On March 16, 2012, Respondent submitted three (3) fictitious policy applications for auto, home, and life insurance in the name of Kimberly Freeman to Farmers.




1 **ORDER**

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

3 Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$750.00 immediately upon entry  
4 of this Order for deposit into the State General Fund.

15 Conclusions of Law and Order.


16 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be

21 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this  
22 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

1           5.       Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
2 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,  
3 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal  
4 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

5           6.       Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
6 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)  
7 and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications  
8 either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.
