ORDER

Respondent.

On December 12, 2012, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Sondra J. Vanella, issued an Administrative Law Judge Decision ("Recommended Decision"), received by the Director of the Department of Insurance ("Director") on December 12, 2012, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.08(B), the Director may review the Recommended Decision and accept, reject or modify it. If the Director modifies the Recommended Decision, the Director must file with the office and serve on all parties a copy of the Recommended Decision with the modification and a written justification setting forth the reasons for the modification.

The Director makes the following modification to the Recommended Decision because the Department considers a real estate salesperson's license to be an equivalent license to an insurance producer's license within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(9):

On page 4 remove paragraph 5 and renumber paragraph 6 as paragraph 5.

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ORDER

1. The Director adopts the Recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as modified.

2. The Director upholds the Department's determination to refuse to renew **Lakisha LaTray Alsaadi's** Arizona producer license (# 929465).

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 41-1092.09, Respondent may request a rehearing with respect to this order by filing a written motion with the Director of the Department of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for relief under A.A.C. R20-6-114(B). Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, it is not necessary to request a rehearing before filing an appeal to Superior Court.

Respondent may appeal the final decision of the Director to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166. A party filing an appeal must notify the Office of Administrative Hearings of the appeal within ten days after filing the complaint commencing the appeal, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-904(B).
