CONSENT ORDER

Hearing 11/21/12, 8:00 a.m.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Amie Michelle Alongi** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Amie Michelle Alongi ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident adjuster, Arizona license number 987163, which expires June 30, 2014.
2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: 14902 North 73rd Street, Scottsdale, Arizona 85260 (business); 8051 W. Via Montoya Dr., Peoria, Arizona 85383 (mailing and residence).
3. On or about March 8, 2011, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as an adjuster, Arizona license number 987163.
4. On October 31, 2011, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her mailing/residence address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before November 30, 2011.
5. On April 25, 2012, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at her mailing/residence address of record that it was about to initiate an administrative action

1 against her license for failure to comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department
2 requested a response by May 15, 2012.

3 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
4 Department.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

7 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
8 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
9 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

10 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
11 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

12 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
13 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
14 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

15 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
16 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
17 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

18 **ORDER**

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

20 1. Respondent shall immediately submit to the Department a full set of fingerprints
21 and an Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form.

22 2. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department a civil money penalty in the
23 amount of \$100.00.

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1 3. The hearing, Docket #12A-122-INS, scheduled for November 21, 2012, at 8:00
2 a.m. is vacated.

7 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

8 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law
9 and Order.

10 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of
11 Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the foregoing
12 Conclusions of Law and Order.

13 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and a hearing at which she may be
14 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
15 waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
16 Order.

17 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
18 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
19 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

20 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
21 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
22 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
23 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

1 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
2 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
3 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
4 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
5 administrative action on any license application.
