CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Malcolm Dean Blissard ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health and life insurance producer, Arizona license number 59230, which expires on May 31, 2013.
2. Respondent's address of record is: 8497 E. Montello Rd., Scottsdale, Arizona 85266 (business, mailing, and residence).
3. Respondent was at all material times contracted with USHEALTH Advisors, LLC ("USHEALTH") and appointed with Freedom Life Insurance Company of America ("Freedom Life") to transact insurance on their behalf Arizona.

1 4. On September 12, 2012, the Department sent to Respondent via email a
2 subpoena requiring him to appear before the Department on September 25, 2012 at 10:00 AM
3 to provide testimony in the matter of eight (8) fictitious health insurance applications submitted
4 to Freedom Life.

5 5. On September 24, 2012, the Department received confirmation that the
6 Respondent received the subpoena.

7 6. On September 25, 2012, Respondent failed to comply with the subpoena.

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

10 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of
11 Title 20 or a subpoena of the director, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).


12 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
13 Respondent's insurance license and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and
14 (F).

15 **ORDER**

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

17 1. Respondent's license is revoked effective immediately upon entry of this Order.

6 Conclusions of Law and Order.


7 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and to a hearing, at which he may be

10 Order.

11 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
12 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
13 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

14 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
15 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
16 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
17 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

18 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
19 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)
20 and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications
21 either to the Department or other States' Departments of Insurance.


