- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Affirmative Insurance Company (AIC), NAIC No. 42609, the surviving entity, an Illinois domiciled insurer effective November 19, 2012. AIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- The Insurance Commissioner of Illinois approved the merger of Petitioner into AIC on November 1, 2012.
