Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Crown Life Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Canadian domiciled, with Michigan as its port of entry, insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective August 30, 1949.
- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into The Canada Life Assurance Company (CLIC), NAIC No. 80659, the surviving entity, a Canadian domiciled, with Michigan as its port of entry, insurer effective December 31, 2012. CLIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Minister of Finance of Ottawa, Canada approved the merger of Petitioner into CLIC on December 13, 2012 and the Insurance Commissioner of Michigan approved the merger of Petitioner into CLIC on December 7, 2012.
