2 is securing a loan, of the licensee A.R.S. §20-295(A)(14)(a).

3 6. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes presenting, causing to
4 be presented or preparing with the knowledge or belief that it will be presented an oral or
5 written statement, including computer generated documents, to or by an insurer, reinsurer,
6 purported insurer or reinsurer, insurance producer or agent of a reinsurer that contains untrue
7 statements of material fact or that fails to state any material fact with respect to an application
8 for the issuance or renewal of an insurance policy within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-
9 463(A)(1)(a).


10 7. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
11 Respondent's insurance license and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and
12 (F).

13 **ORDER**

14 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 15 1. Respondent's license is hereby revoked effective immediately upon entry of this
16 Order.
17 2. Respondent shall immediately make restitution to Farmers in the amount of
18 \$6,804.90.

17 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.


18 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
