**CONSENT ORDER**

**Respondent.**

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jessica Marie Gomez ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident casualty and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 1015962, which expires November 30, 2015.

2. Respondent's addresses of record are: c/o Servicios Unidos, 2050 N. 16<sup>th</sup> St., #A, Phoenix, Arizona 85006 (business and mailing) and 1613 E. Brill St., #3, Phoenix, Arizona 85006 (residence).

3. Respondent was at all material times contracted with United Automobile Insurance Company ("UAIC") to transact insurance on its behalf in Arizona.

1 reapply for the same authority or license for at least one year after the date of surrender  
2 pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-289(F).

3 6. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew  
4 Respondent's insurance license and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and  
5 (F).


6 **ORDER**

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

8 1. Respondent may surrender her insurance producer license, Arizona license  
9 number 1015962.

10 2. Respondent shall immediately make restitution to UAIC in the amount of  
11 \$365.00.

2 Order.


3 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as  
4 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this  
5 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
7 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,  
8 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil  
9 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

10 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
11 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
12 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to  
13 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this  
14 administrative action on any license application.
