CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jessica Delgado Hernandez** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jessica Delgado Hernandez ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/health and life insurance producer, Arizona license number 1060952, which expires on December 31, 2016. Respondent first became licensed with the Department on October 21, 2013.
- 2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: 12955 W. Saguaro Lane, Surprise, AZ 85374 (business, mailing and residence).
- 3. On or about October 21, 2013, Respondent submitted an Application for an Individual Insurance License ("October 21 2013 Application"). Section V, part C of the October 21 2013 Application asks: Have you ever been found guilty of, have you had a judgment made against you for, or have you admitted to, any of the following: 1. A felony (of any kind)? . . . Respondent answered Yes to Question 1. Respondent signed the October 21 2013 Application.
- 4. In connection to her "Yes" response to Section V, part C, Question 1 of the October 21 2013 Application, Respondent included court documents for State of Arizona v.

Jessica Delgado Hernandez; Docket No. CR2008-154029 ("CR2008-154029"). The Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County adjudged Respondent guilty of Aggravated Assault, a Class 3 Felony and sentenced Respondent to be incarcerated for 3.5 years.

5. On or about October 21, 2013, Respondent submitted an Arizona Application for Consent to Engage in the Business of Insurance under 18 USC § 1033 ("1033 Waiver"). In the Statement portion of the 1033 Waiver, Respondent stated "Legal documents are attached to license application."

- 6. On or about May 19, 1999, the U.S. District Court, District of Nebraska (8 Omaha) entered a Judgment and Commitment in USA v. Hernandez, Criminal Docket Number 8:98-cr-00159-TMS-1 ("Case 8:98-cr-00159"). In Case 8:98-cr-00159, the Court found Respondent guilty of one count of Conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute methamphetamine, a felony. The Court sentenced Respondent to be incarcerated for 30 months with 3 years of supervised release.
- 7. Respondent did not supply any court documents to the Department for Case 8:98-cr-00159 or explain why she could not provide the documents.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct as described above, constitutes obtaining or attempting to obtain a license through misrepresentation or fraud, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(3).
- 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).
- 4. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension, revocation or refusal to renew a license for the Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars or impose a civil penalty of not more than two thousand five

hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation up to an aggregate civil penalty of fifteen thousand dollars, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

 Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$125.00 for deposit into the State General Fund.
