18	the Department that Respondent's bond was to be cancelled, effective 30 days from the date

1	2	3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of the	
1	3	requirement that every administrator shall possess and maintain a deposit in favor of this State	
1	4	to be held in trust for the benefit and protection of insureds and insurers whose monies the	
1	5	administrator handles, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-485.10.
