11	Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance	
12	("Department"), the Director finds as follows:	
13	FINDINGS OF FACT	
14	1. Anesthesiologists Professional Assurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Florida	
15	domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact casualty	
16	insurance in Arizona effective March 19, 2001.	
17	2. The Assumption Reinsurance Agreement ("ARA") between Petitioner and The	
18	Doctors' Company, an Interinsurance Exchange, and the merger of Petitioner into FPIC	
19	Insurance Group, Inc. were approved by the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation on April	
20	16, 2014. The ARA is effective March 31, 2014 and the merger is effective May 19, 2014.	
21	3. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has	
22	voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.

1	4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whethe
2	written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are
3	residents of this State.
4	5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduc
5	examination and does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
6	6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
7	("IERF").
8	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
9	Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
10	303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from the
11	insurance business.
12	ORDER
13	1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.
14	2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
15	previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
