ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant  
Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance  
("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Metlife Investors USA Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Delaware domiciled  
insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability  
insurance in Arizona effective December 8, 1980.

2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Metlife Insurance Company USA  
(MICUSA), NAIC No. 87726, the surviving entity, a Delaware domiciled insurer effective  
November 14, 2014. MICUSA is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner  
voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Delaware approved the merger of Petitioner into  
MICUSA on October 17, 2014.

4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether  
written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are  
residents of this State.

1 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
2 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.


3 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

7 The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.


