FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Metlife Investors USA Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Delaware domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective December 8, 1980.
- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Metlife Insurance Company USA (MICUSA), NAIC No. 87726, the surviving entity, a Delaware domiciled insurer effective November 14, 2014. MICUSA is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- The Insurance Commissioner of Delaware approved the merger of Petitioner into
 MICUSA on October 17, 2014.
- 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
