ORDER

9 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant
 10 Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance
 11 ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 13 1. Metlife Investors Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Missouri domiciled
 14 insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability
 15 insurance in Arizona effective November 2, 1982.
 - 16 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Metlife Insurance Company USA
 17 (MICUSA), NAIC No. 87726, the surviving entity, a Delaware domiciled insurer effective
 18 November 14, 2014. MICUSA is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner
 19 voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
 - 20 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Missouri approved the merger of Petitioner into
 21 MICUSA on June 26, 2014.

1 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether
2 written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are
3 residents of this State.

4 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
5 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

6 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
7 ("IERF").

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


9 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
10 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

11 **ORDER**

12 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

13 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
14 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
