**ORDER**

9 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant  
10 Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"),  
11 the Director finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

12  
13 1. Shelby Casualty Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Texas domiciled insurance  
14 company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in  
15 Arizona effective April 30, 1959.

16 2. On June 28, 2006, the 126<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court of Travis County, Texas  
17 ("Receivership Court") found the Petitioner to be insolvent and entered the Agreed Order  
18 Appointing Rehabilitator and Permanent Injunction. Prime Tempus, Inc. filed its Notice of  
19 Designation of Special Deputy Receiver on July 11, 2006. On August 1, 2006, the Receivership  
20 Court entered the Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction.

21 3. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has  
22 voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.  
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1 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations, other than those currently pending with  
2 the Arizona Guaranty Association, under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or  
3 through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.  
4 All policies issued in Arizona were cancelled effective August 24, 2006.

5 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
6 examination and does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

7 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund  
8 ("IERF").

9 7. Petitioner filed its financial report as of February 28, 2015 with the Department.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-  
12 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from the insurance  
13 business.

14 **ORDER**

- 15 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.  
16 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was  
17 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
