Prime Tempus, Inc. filed its Notice of 19 Designation of Special Deputy Receiver on July 11, 2006. On August 1, 2006, the Receivership 20 Court entered the Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction. 21 Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has 3. 22 voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.

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- Petitioner has no outstanding obligations, other than those currently pending with 4. the Arizona Guaranty Association, under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State. All policies issued in Arizona were cancelled effective August 24, 2006.
- Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct 5. examination and does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
- Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund 6. ("IERF").
 - 7. Petitioner filed its financial report as of February 28, 2015 with the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from the insurance business.
