R20-6-114(B). Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, it is not necessary to request a rehearing before filing an appeal to Superior Court.

1	Respondent may appeal the final decision of the Director to the Superior Court of

FINDINGS OF FACT

- On June 2, 2015, the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") 1. issued a Notice of Hearing and Complaint setting the above-captioned matter for hearing at 1:00 p.m. July 15, 2015, at the Office of Administrative Hearings in Phoenix, Arizona.
- In the Notice of Hearing and Complaint, the Department alleges 2. Respondent Lynn Robert Goldney has violated ARIZ. REV. STAT. sections 20-301(A) and 20-295(A)(1) and (A)(2).
- Mr. Goldney did not appear at the scheduled hearing time and the matter 3. was convened in his absence at about 1:20 p.m.
- The Department presented the testimony of its Licensing Manager, Steven 4. Fromholtz.
- Mr. Goldney holds license number 462692 that will expire on March 31, 5. 2017.
- The Department received a Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc. 6. ("FINRA") report showing that as of December 7, 2012 Mr. Goldney had been

suspended from FINRA and that as of February 19, 2014 FINRA had entered a permanent bar against him.

- 7. The FINRA report shows that the Arizona Corporation Commission had taken disciplinary action against Mr. Goldney because he inappropriately borrowed money from customers.
- 8. In an Order dated May 8, 2013, the Arizona Corporation Commission revoked Mr. Goldney's securities salesman registration and imposed a civil penalty against him.
- 9. Mr. Goldney did not report to the Department that he had been twice sanction by FINRA or that he had been disciplined by the Arizona Corporation Commission.
- 10. On April 8, 2013, Mr. Goldney filed with the Department an application to renew his license. In that application, Mr. Goldney answered "no" in response to whether he had been named or involved as a party in any administrative proceedings that had not been previously reported to the Department. The question specifically identified FINRA sanctions as being subject to this reporting requirement.
- 11. At the hearing, the Department requested that Mr. Goldney's license be revoked.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Department bears the burden of persuasion. ARIZ. REV. STAT. § 41-1092.07(G)(2).
- 2. The standard of proof on all issues is that of a preponderance of the evidence. ARIZ. ADMIN. CODE § R2-19-119(A).
- 3. A preponderance of the evidence is "[e]vidence which is of greater weight or more convincing than the evidence which is offered in opposition to it; that is, evidence which as a whole shows that the fact sought to be proved is more probable than not." Black's Law Dictionary 1182 (6th ed. 1990).
- 4. The preponderance of the evidence shows that Mr. Goldney did not report to the Department that the Arizona Corporation Commission had entered a disciplinary

Order against him, which is a violation ARIZ. REV. STAT. sections 20-301(A) and 20-295(A)(2).

5. The preponderance of the evidence shows that the April 8, 2013 renewal application Mr. Goldney submitted to the Department contained incorrect or materially

6. Based on the proven violations of ARIZ. REV. STAT. sections 20-295(A)(1) and (A)(2) and 20-301(A), the Department has authority to impose discipline against Mr. Goldney's license.

untrue information, which is a violation of ARIZ. REV. STAT. sections 20-295(A)(1) and

- 7. Mr. Goldney's failure to appear at the hearing is considered to be a factory in aggravation.
- 8. Based on the facts and circumstances of this matter, Mr. Goldney's license should be revoked.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Lynn Robert Goldney's license number 462692 is revoked.

In the event of certification of the Administrative Law Judge Decision by the Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings, the effective date of the Order will be five days after the date of that certification.
