Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry 10 of the following Conclusions of Law and Order. 11 12 FINDINGS OF FACT 1. Equity Insurance Company ("Equity") at all material times held a certificate of 13 authority to transact insurance as a property and casualty insurer in Arizona. 14 2. From January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, Equity non-renewed four (4) 15 personal automobile insurance policies issued to Arizona policyholders that had been in effect 16 for more than sixty (60 days) at the time the notice of non-renewal was mailed. 17 18 3. Equity provided information to the policyholders explaining why the policies were not renewed, and the reasons provided are not permitted by Arizona statute. 19 From January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, Equity non-renewed four (4) 4. 20 personal automobile insurance policies issued to Arizona policyholders and failed to provide a 21 compliant Summary of Rights to all four policyholders. 22 23

5. From January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, Equity non-renewed four (4) personal automobile insurance policies issued to Arizona policyholders and failed to state the specific facts that constitute the reasons for the nonrenewal.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Equity violated ARS §20-1631(D) by failing to non-renew personal automobile insurance policies that have been in effect for sixty (60) days for reasons permitted by statute.
- 3. Equity violated ARS §20-2110 by failing to send policyholders a compliant Summary of Rights in the event of an adverse underwriting decision.
- 4. Equity violated ARS §20-1632(A) by failing to state the specific facts that constitute the reasons for nonrenewal when non-renewing personal automobile insurance policies.
- 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Respondent's certificate of authority or to impose a civil penalty pursuant to ARS §20-220(A).
- 6. The Director may impose, in lieu of or in addition to suspension or revocation a penalty not to exceed an aggregate of ten thousand dollars within any six-month period for unintentional violations or a penalty not to exceed an aggregate of fifty thousand dollars within any six-month period for intentional violations, within the meaning of ARS § 20-220(B).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Equity Insurance Company shall:
- a. use only reasons allowed by statute to non-renew private passenger automobile policies.

- b. provide insureds a compliant Summary of Rights in the event of an adverse underwriting decision.
- c. state the specific facts that constitute the reasons for nonrenewal when nonrenewing personal automobile insurance policies.
- 2. Within 90 days of the filed date of this Order, Equity Insurance Company shall submit to the Arizona Department of Insurance, for approval, evidence that Equity implemented corrections and communicated these corrections to the appropriate personnel, regarding the issues outlined in Paragraph 1 of the Order section of this Consent Order. Evidence of corrective action and communication thereof includes, but is not limited to, memos, bulletins, E-mails, correspondence, procedures manuals, print screens, and training materials.
- 3. The Department shall, through authorized representatives, verify that Equity has complied with all provisions of this Order.
- 4. Equity shall pay a civil penalty of \$12,000.00 to the Director for deposit into the State General Fund.

- 7. Charles M. Davis represents that he is the President of Equity Insurance Company and, as such, is authorized to enter this Consent Order on its behalf.
