CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Roxanne Debra Anderson** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Roxanne Debra Anderson ("Anderson" or "Respondent") was, at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident property and casualty insurance producer and bail bond agent, Arizona license number 939418, which expires on January 31, 2017.

2. Anderson's address of record is: 712 California Ave., Parker, Arizona 85344 (business and mailing).

3. On or about August 3, 2015, In the Superior Court of the State of Arizona in and for the County of La Paz, State of Arizona vs. Roxanne Anderson, Case Number CR2014-00107, the Court filed a Sentence of Probation convicting Anderson of Forgery, a class 4 felony.

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1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

3 2. The Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes having been
4 convicted of a felony, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(6) as applied to bail bond
5 agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06 and A.R.S. § 20-340.03(A)(9).


6 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
7 Respondent's insurance license pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

8 **ORDER**

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

10 1. Respondent's license, Arizona license number 939418, is revoked effective
11 immediately.

23 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
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1 waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
2 Order.

3 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
4 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
5 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
7 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
8 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
9 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

10 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
11 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)
12 and that she may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications
13 either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.
