- 3. On or about August 3, 2015, In the Superior Court of the State of Arizona in and for the County of La Paz, State of Arizona vs. Roxanne Anderson, Case Number CR2014-00107, the Court filed a Sentence of Probation convicting Anderson of Forgery, a class 4 felony.

- Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew 3. Respondent's insurance license pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Respondent's license, Arizona license number 939418, is revoked effective 1. immediately.
