FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Arizona Department of Health Services issued a Notice of Hearing setting the above-captioned matter for hearing at 1:00 p.m. on March 26, 2016, at the Office of Administrative Hearings in Phoenix, Arizona.
 - 2. On March 25, 2016, reducted

the matter was continued until 1:00 p.m., May 12, 2016. Written notice of the continued hearing was transmitted to Petitioner on March 28, 2016.

3. No representative for Petitioner appeared by 1:15 p.m. and consequently. the matter was not convened and no evidence was taken.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The burden of proof at an administrative hearing falls to the party asserting a claim, right, or entitlement, and the standard of proof on all issues in this matter is by a preponderance of the evidence. See A.A.C. R2-19-119.
- 2. Because Petitioner failed to appear and prosecute the appeal, the appeal is unsupported by evidence. Consequently, Petitioner's appeal should be dismissed.
