The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **DANIELLE A. MIRANDA** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Danielle A. Miranda ("Respondent") is and was at all material times licensed as a Personal Lines (Property/Casualty) producer, Arizona license number 1116501, which expires November 30, 2018.
2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are 5353 W. Bell Road, Glendale, AZ 85308 (business) and 2030 W. Tracy Lane, Phoenix, AZ 85023 (mailing).
3. On or about July 17, 2015, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a Personal Lines (Property/Casualty) producer, Arizona license number 1116501.
4. On October 26, 2015, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before November 22, 2015. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

1 3. The hearing, Docket #16A-027-INS, scheduled for August 17, 2016, at 1:00 p.m.
2 is vacated.

15 waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
16 Order.

17 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
18 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
19 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

20 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
21 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
22 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
23 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

1 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
2 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
3 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
4 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
5 administrative action on any license application.


