ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

Respondents.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **7710 Insurance Company and Wiatt Edmund Wong ("Respondents")** unlawfully transacted insurance business, as provided in Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 20-106 in the State of Arizona without a certificate of authority from the Department. Accordingly, the Interim Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Interim Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-401.02.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 7710 Insurance Company ("7710 Insurance") is a South Carolina corporation that,
 at all times, did not hold a Certificate of Authority with the Department as a Workers'
 Compensation carrier.
- 7710 Insurance's address of record is: 1 North Cantey Road, Summerton, SC
 29148 (business and mailing) according to the South Carolina Department of Insurance.
 - 3. 7710 Insurance is not exempt from the licensing requirement.

- 4. Wiatt Edmund Wong ("Wong") is, and was at all times material, licensed as a resident accident/health, life, casualty and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 30058, which expires on November 30, 2018.
- 5. Wong's addresses of record with the Department are; JW & Associates dba VFIS of AZ, 2583 W. Kit Carson Trail, Anthem, Arizona 85086 (business) and P.O. Box 75218, Phoenix, Arizona 85087 (mailing).

DEPARTMENT COMPLAINTS

6. On December 28, 2015, the Department received a complaint alleging that 7710 Insurance had solicited in Arizona fire districts to sell Workers' Compensation insurance. On April 28, 2016, the Department received a second complaint alleging that the Respondents were marketing Workers' Compensation insurance in Arizona and the complaint included a flyer titled "Why Choose 7710 Insurance" and a pamphlet titled "7710 Insurance, Specialized Workers' Compensation Insurance." Each of these documents were purported to have been obtained at presentations or seminars hosted by 7710 Insurance and producer Wiatt Wong for Arizona fire districts.

FIRE DISTRICT INFORMATION

7. The Department secured Board Meeting Minutes from the websites of the Sun City Fire District (June 9, 2015), Superstition Fire & Medical District (December 16, 2015), and Highlands Fire District (January 19, 2016). The Board Meeting Minutes support that 7710 Insurance, through Wiatt Wong, conducted presentations, presented proposals, accepted and approved applications, or offered incentives to fire districts to sign with 7710 Insurance for Workers' Compensation insurance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. It is unlawful for any insurer to transact insurance business as provided in A.R.S. § 20-106 in this state without a certificate of authority from the Interim Director. A.R.S. § 20-401.01.
- 3. 7710 Insurance's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes transacting insurance business in this state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-106.
- 4. Wong's conduct, as alleged above, constitutes aiding or assisting any person in the unauthorized transaction of insurance business, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(11).
- 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to order 7710 Insurance and Wong to cease and desist engaging in the transaction of insurance, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-401.02.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Respondents shall immediately cease and desist from unlawfully transacting insurance business in this state.
- 2. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

Pursuant to Title 20 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Respondents are hereby notified that they may request a hearing pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-161 to contest the order to cease and desist. Such a request must be in writing and received at the following address within thirty (30) days from the date hereof:

Upon receipt of a timely written request for hearing, the Director will issue an order setting the time and place of the hearing.
