Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Tower National Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Massachusetts domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective September 19, 2006.
- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Castlepoint National Insurance Company (CNIC), NAIC No. 40134, the surviving entity, a California domiciled insurer effective July 28, 2016. CNIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- The Insurance Commissioner of Massachusetts approved the merger of Petitioner into CNIC on July 18, 2016.

- 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
- 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.
 - 6. The Department holds a \$105,000 retaliatory deposit on behalf of the Petitioner.
- 7. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF").

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

ORDER

- 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.
- 2. The Department shall transfer the \$105,000 retaliatory deposit of the Petitioner to CNIC's account with the Department and it shall be held as a retaliatory deposit of CNIC.
- 3. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
