- Preserver Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a New Jersey domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective November 4, 2008.
- 2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Castlepoint National Insurance Company (CNIC), NAIC No. 40134, the surviving entity, a California domiciled insurer effective July 28, 2016. CNIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of New Jersey approved the merger of Petitioner into CNIC on July 11, 2016.
