On June 6, 2017, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge Suzanne Marwil, issued an Administrative Law Judge Decision ("Recommended Decision"), received by the Interim Director of the Department of Insurance ("Interim Director") on June 6, 2017, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Interim Director of the Department of Insurance has reviewed the Recommended Decision and enters the following Order:

1. The Interim Director adopts the Recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
2. The Interim Director revokes the Arizona resident insurance producer license of **Marjorie Gretchen Adams** effective immediately.
3. Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty to the Department of \$22.00.


NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 41-1092.09, Respondent may request a rehearing with respect to this order by filing a written motion with the Interim Director of the Department of Insurance within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting

1 forth the basis for relief under A.A.C. R20-6-114(B). Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, it is
2 not necessary to request a rehearing before filing an appeal to Superior Court.

3 Respondent may appeal the final decision of the Interim Director to the Superior
4 Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166. A party filing an
5 appeal must notify the Office of Administrative Hearings of the appeal within ten days after
6 filing the complaint commencing the appeal, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-904(B).

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18 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

19 1. On May 20, 2014, the Department licensed Marjorie Gretchen Adams
20 ("Adams" or "Respondent") as an Arizona resident life insurance producer, Arizona
21 license number 1077499, which expires on February 28, 2018.

22 2. Respondent's address of record is: 1605 N. 1271h Ave., Avondale, AZ
23 85392 (business and mailing).

24 3. On May 20, 2014, Respondent submitted an Application for an
25 Individual Insurance License (the "Application"). With the Application, Respondent
26 submitted check number 1037 in the amount of \$142.00, which paid for both her
27 licensing fee (\$120.00) and for processing her fingerprint card (\$22.00).

28 4. On May 23, 2014, the Arizona State Treasurer returned check number
29 1037 to the Department because the bank had returned the check as "Altered/Fictitious".

1 Based upon the above, Respondent's license shall be revoked on the effective
2 date of the Order entered in this matter.

3 Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$22.00 to the Department, which represents
4 the cost of the Department obtaining Respondent's fingerprint clearance.

5 *In the event of certification of the Administrative Law Judge Decision by the*
6 *Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings, the effective date of the Order will be*
7 *five (5) days from the date of that certification.*
