The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Robert Stephen Buckshaw ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 871738, which expires on December 31, 2017. Respondent first became licensed with the Department on August 16, 2006.
- Respondent's address of record is: 3813 W. Commonwealth Ave., Chandler, AZ 85226-5037 (business and mailing).

#### **FAILURE TO NOTIFY**

3. On or about December 16, 2015, in the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa County ("Court"), the Court held an Initial Pretrial Conference in State of Arizona v. Robert Stephen Buckshaw, CR2015-148482.

4. Respondent failed to notify the Department of the criminal prosecution in writing within thirty days of the initial pretrial hearing date.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. The Interim Director may accept the voluntary surrender of a person's license, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-289(F).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to notify the director of any criminal prosecution of the producer taken in any jurisdiction within thirty days after the initial pretrial hearing date, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-301(B).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of Title 20, or any rule, subpoena or order of the director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to deny, suspend for not more than twelve months, revoke, or refuse to renew an insurance producer's license pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

#### ORDER

#### IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Respondent may surrender his resident insurance producer license, Arizona license number 871738.

- 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to

3	7. Respondent acknowledges that a person who surrenders a license shall not
4	reapply for the same license for at least one year after the date of the surrender.
