**CONSENT ORDER**

**Respondents.**

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Shull & Associates Agency, Inc and Sheri Ann Shull ("Respondents")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Shull & Associates Agency, Inc.<sup>1</sup> ("Shull & Associates") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, personal lines (P&C), property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license number 1134625, which expires December 31, 2019. Shull & Associates first became licensed with the Department on December 22, 2015.

2. Shull & Associates' address of record is: 5852 E. McKellips Rd., Suite 109, Mesa, Arizona 85215-2797 (business and mailing).

3. Sheri Ann Shull ("Shull") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, property and casualty insurance producer, Arizona license

1 number 34998, which expires January 31, 2018. Shull first became licensed with the  
2 Department on October 18, 1995 (property and casualty) and April 29, 2002 (accident/health  
3 and life). Shull last renewed her license on February 1, 2014.

4 4. Shull's address of record is: c/o Allstate Insurance Co., 5852 E. McKellips Rd.,  
5 Suite 109, Mesa, Arizona 85215 (business and mailing).

6 5. Shull is a Member and Designated Responsible Licensed Producer of Shull &  
7 Associates.

8 6. On or about December 5, 2015, Shull & Associates submitted a Form L-177;  
9 Report of a Change to Members, Officers or Directors to the Department ("Form L-177"). The  
10 Form L-177 submitted by Shull & Associates added Lloyd Lee Shull as an Officer ("Lloyd  
11 Shull").

12 7. The Background Questions of Form L-177 ask: C. Has any individual  
13 designated in this report **EVER** been convicted or found guilty of, had a judgment made  
14 against for, or admitted to, any of the following: 1. A felony (of any kind)? Shull & Associates  
15 responded "No" to this question.

16 8. On or about December 15, 1986, the Superior Court of Arizona, Maricopa  
17 County filed a Sentence of Probation in State of Arizona v. Lloyd Lee Shull; Docket No. CR –  
18 160035 ("Docket CR-160035"). The Court found Lloyd Shull guilty of Attempt to Sell a Narcotic  
19 Drug, a class 3 felony in Docket CR-160035.

## 20 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

21 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

1           2.     Respondents admit the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona,  
2 and admit the foregoing Findings of Fact and consent to the entry of the foregoing  
3 Conclusions of Law and Order.

4           3.     Respondents are aware of their right to notice and a hearing at which they may  
5 be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondents  
6 irrevocably waive their right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this  
7 Consent Order.

8           4.     Respondents state that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as  
9 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to them to induce them to enter into this  
10 Consent Order and that they have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

11          5.     Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
12 Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency,  
13 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil  
14 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

15          6.     Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
16 the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).  
17 Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to  
18 any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this  
19 administrative action on any license application.

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
