FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. American Colonial Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a Florida domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective October 15, 2015.
- 2. Effective December 30, 2016, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into White Pine Insurance Company (WPIC), NAIC No. 11932, a Michigan domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. WPIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Florida approved the merger of Petitioner into WPIC on December 22, 2016.
- 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
