

1 Weiss transferring a Deed of Trust was valid and to examine Baldwin about the Weiss
2 complaint.)

3 4. On or about April 14, 2017 at 10:30 a.m., Baldwin failed to appear at the
4 Department or to produce the requested documents.

5 **Failure to Maintain a Place of Business**

6 5. In December, 2016, an Investigator for the Department visited Baldwin's
7 business address of record and found it to be vacant.

8 **Failure to update addresses**

9 6. On or about April 3, 2017, the Department sent correspondence, certified mail, to
10 Baldwin's addresses of record.

11 7. On April 18, 2017, the Post Office returned the correspondence sent to Baldwin's
12 business address of record as: "Return to Sender/Not deliverable as addressed/Attempted –
13 not known.

14 8. On April 23, 2017, the Post Office returned the correspondence sent to Baldwin's
15 residential address of record as: "Return to Sender/Unclaimed/Unable to Forward.

16 9. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

17 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

18 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

19 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of any
20 provision of Title 20, any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S.
21 § 20-295(A)(2) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.

22 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of the
23 requirement that each bail bond agent shall have and maintain a place of business in this state

1 that is accessible to the public and where the bail bond agent principally conducts transactions
2 under the agent's license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-340.01(E).

3 4. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to notify the
4 director in writing, within thirty days, of any change in the licensee's residential or business
5 address, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-286(C)(1) as applied to bail bond agents under
6 A.R.S. § 290340.06.

7 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
8 Respondents' insurance licenses and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and
9 (F) as applied to bail bond agents under A.R.S. § 20-340.06.

10 6. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action,
11 within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

12 **ORDER**

13 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

14 1. Tyler Scott Baldwin's Arizona resident bail bond agent license, National Producer
15 Number 16496682, is summarily suspended, effective immediately upon entry of this Order.
