Financial Life (CFL), NAIC No. 56030, a Wisconsin domiciled fraternal benefit society and the surviving entity. CFL is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Minnesota approved the merger of Petitioner into CFL on May 24, 2017.
- Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether 4. written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
