FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Great Fidelity Life Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is an Indiana domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective October 29, 1982.
- 2. Effective December 31, 2017, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Puritan Life Insurance Company of America (PLICA), NAIC No. 71390, a Texas domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. PLICA is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of Indiana approved the merger of Petitioner into PLICA on December 22, 2017.

1	4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether						
2	written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are						
3	residents of this State.						
4	5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct						
5	examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.						
6	6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund						
7	("IERF").						
8	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW						
9	Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-						
10	303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.
