**CONSENT ORDER**

**Respondent.**

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Robert W. Jamison** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Robert. W. Jamison, ("Respondent") is and was at all material times licensed as a resident insurance producer with lines of authority in property, casualty and personal lines, National Producer Number 18421316, which expires December 31, 2020.

2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Progressive Insurance, 4550 S. 44<sup>th</sup> Place, Phoenix, AZ 85040 (business) and 11619 W. Cyprus Dr., Avondale, AZ 85392 (mailing). Respondent's business e-mail is:

3. On or about June 6, 2017, the Department issued to Respondent a license as an insurance producer, National Producer Number 18421316.

1 4. On November 6, 2017, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his  
2 address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona  
3 Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set  
4 of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before  
5 November 30, 2017. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

6 5. On March 2, 2018, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at  
7 his address of record that his fingerprints had been returned by DPS as illegible and that the  
8 Department was about to initiate an administrative action against his license for failure to  
9 comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a response by March 30,  
10 2018.

11 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the  
12 Department.

### 13 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

14 1. The Interim Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

15 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the  
16 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the  
17 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

18 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete  
19 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

20 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any  
21 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of  
22 A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).



1 waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent  
2 Order.

3 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as  
4 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this  
5 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
7 Interim Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other  
8 agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or  
9 criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

10 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
11 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
12 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to  
13 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative  
14 action on any license application.
