CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jeanette Crane Taylor** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jeanette Crane Taylor ("Respondent") is and was at all material times licensed as a resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 18305816, which expires August 31, 2020. The Department issued to Respondent a license as an insurance producer with lines of authority in property and casualty on February 2, 2017, and life on March 31, 2017.

2. Respondent's business address of record with the Department is: 4895 S. Higley Rd., Gilbert, AZ 85298 and her business e-mail is JEANETTE.TAYLOR77@GMAIL.COM.

3. On or about February 2, 2017, the Department issued to Respondent a license as an insurance producer, National Producer Number 18305816. On or about March 31, 2017, the Department added a line of authority to Respondent's insurance producer license.


1 5. Grounds exist for the Interim Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
2 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
3 A.R.S. §§ 20-295(A) and (F).

4 **ORDER**

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 6 1. Respondent shall immediately submit her fingerprints and an Illegible Fingerprint
7 Replacement Form to the Department.
- 8 2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to the
9 Department, due upon the submission of this Consent Order.
- 10 3. The hearing, Docket #18A-057-INS, scheduled for September 28, 2018, at 1:00
11 p.m. is vacated.

4 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
5 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
7 Interim Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other
8 agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or
9 criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

10 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
11 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
12 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
13 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
14 administrative action on any license application.
